

Taiwan's biomedical sector grows continuously and investment into the sector increases annually



CAGR from 2008-2017 is 5.5%

Overall Revenue of 10.66 million USD for 2017

3.23 billion USD for applied biotechnology

2.63 billion USD for pharmaceuticals

4.80 billion USD for medical devices



Total Investment of 17.3 million USD (a growth of 3.3% compared to 2016) from 118 investments (24 investments more than 2016) for 2017
